RULEBOOK

1. Overview

Welcome to our 24-hour Hackathon! This event is a celebration of innovation, creativity, and collaboration. Participants will have the opportunity to create meaningful solutions, gain hands-on experience, and network with peers and professionals.

2. Eligibility

- ✓ Open to all students pursuing undergraduate or postgraduate degrees.
- ✓ Teams must register prior to the deadline to be eligible.
- ✓ A team can have a minimum of 2 and a maximum of 4 members.
- ✓ All registered teams are allowed to participate in the final event.

3. Team Formation

- **✓** Teams should consist of students from the same or different institutions.
- ✓ Interdisciplinary teams are encouraged.
- ✓ Team members must be registered as a team via the official registration form.

4. Hackathon Format

- ✓ This is a single-round, 24-hour hackathon.
- ✓ The event will start and end as per the scheduled timeline shared with participants.
- ✓ Participants must submit their final projects before the deadline for evaluation.

5. Themes

The theme of the hackathon is "Tech for a Better Tomorrow." The problem statement is openended, allowing participants to choose their own.

6. Technology Stack

- ✓ Participants are free to use any programming languages, tools, or platforms.
- ✓ Open-source tools and libraries are allowed.
- ✓ Plagiarism of code or content is strictly prohibited.

7. Judging Criteria

Projects will be judged based on:

- ✓ Innovation & Creativity Uniqueness of the idea
- ✓ Functionality Working demo and completeness
- ✓ Impact Usefulness and scalability
- ✓ Technical Difficulty Complexity of implementation
- ✓ Presentation Clarity of idea and user experience

8. Submission Guidelines

Final project submission must include:

- ✓ Source code (via GitHub or drive link)
- ✓ Demo video (up to 3 minutes)
- ✓ Brief project description and team details

Submissions must be made before the deadline to be eligible.

9. Mentorship & Support

- ✓ Mentors will be available during the hackathon for guidance.
- ✓ Teams are encouraged to ask questions and seek feedback throughout the event.

10. Code of Conduct

- ✓ Respect fellow participants, mentors, and organizers.
- ✓ Any form of cheating, harassment, or misconduct will lead to disqualification.
